


NIA Paul Hendler Scholarship Scholarship Application Form NIA Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- 1. The Applicant must be a High School senior or in college and be enrolled full time in school. The Scholarship can be used for any college or tech school.
- 2. NIA Industry and Associate Member company's employees and their employee's children or grandchildren are eligible to apply for this Scholarship that has their dues paid and has been a member of the NIA for at least one year.
- 3. Transcript from their High School, College, University, or Tech School including their cumulative GPA must be provided.
- 4. The Applicant should write a brief summary of their goals in life.
- 5. Applications must be postmarked no later than Feburary 1
- 6. Applications will be sent to and voted on by the NIA board members.
- 7. A letter of recommendation for the applicant must be submitted by a member of the NIA as explained above and returned with the applications or sent separately before the deadline to the NIA Executive Director.


Notification of Winners

- 5. Appreciation letter, if given by the applicant will be ready to the membership doing the business meeting at the Fall Convention.


Guidelines for summary of their goals in life
